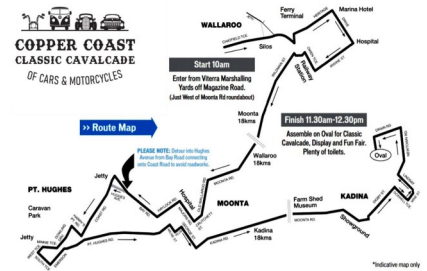
COPPER COAST CORNISH FESTIVAL

This event is held every 2 years and starts at Wallaroo, goes down to Moonta and finishes at the Kadina oval. It attracts over 500 vehicles of all makes and ages (cars and people). I have attended every run since I bought my vette late 2010, so my 1st run was in 2011. Now it's such a good days outing that I like to share, so I get a gathering of club members to tag along with me.

This year there were 6 of us brave vetters. We met at the ungodly hour of 6:30am at the OTR at Bolivar. The reason it's such an early meet is because I don't like to be at the tail end of the run, been there, no fun.... It was brisk and a bit nippy in the car park, but once we left at 6:45, those with working heaters were toasty, the rest of us just rugged up. Uneventful run over except for the 3 speed cameras set up the other side of Port Wakefield, to take holiday snaps, guess that's why it's called the "copper coast".



We arrived just before 8:30, paid our entry fee and joined the queue. (see photo, we were in the 5th row near the front, photo was taken after the 1st couple of rows had started moving off). Some Members represented the club at the Horsepower Crew's Wintertime Show and Shine, held at Wayville Showgrounds on 24th of May.

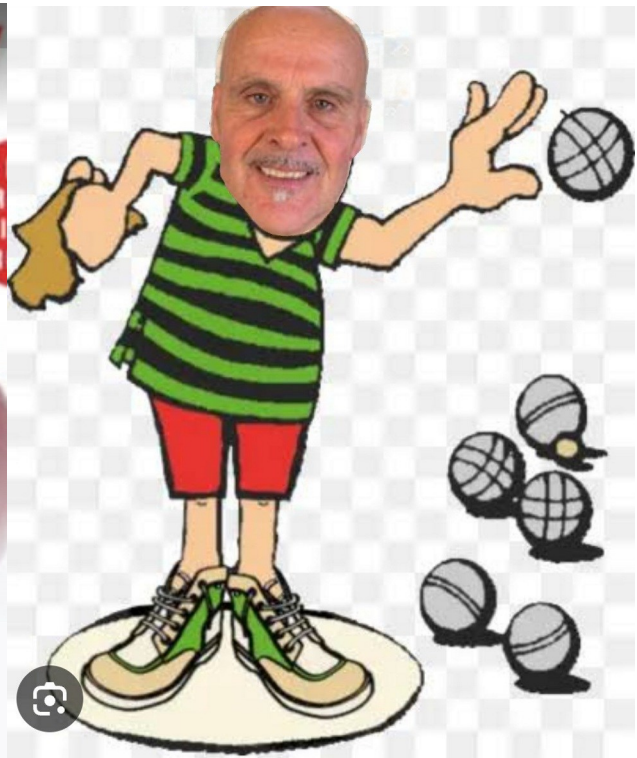

Proposed Road Trip

For those of you who are giving consideration to attending this special annual event the following is being considered and with **your advanced input, to me by 30th November 2025 for the overnight travel arrangements** to ensure appropriate bookings can be made.

For the full National program put together by the Queensland Corvette Club refer to their document included in this newsletter and on our club web site.

As mentioned in the last club Newsletter there will be three overnight stops on the way to the event with the option to either leave –

- On the Monday 16th to arrive Thursday 19th. This gives a brief break before the busy week-end.
From previous experience this is the preferred time manageable way.
- Or on the Tuesday 17th to arrive Friday 20th and on that day also pick up your entry bag and Corvette preparation.

To travel as a group, particularly on a long trip as this, does not only give support to each other but is a great social event to share stories along the way.

The overnight stops are Hay 655kms, 7hrs. Coonabarabran 676kms, 7hrs. Warwick to Noosa 298kms, 4hrs.

These distances take into consideration comfortable travelling times as well as for the older Corvettes which do not have the same creature comfort as those younger.

Once I have your thoughts I will make the appropriate motel bookings for the type of accommodation required and you pay the establishment on check out.

As a guide an overnight stop is approximately \$180 but this will vary dependent on the establishment and how many rooms are booked.

To keep costs down and in addition of reviewing the accommodation prices at the Nationals, I have booked alternative accommodation, only two rooms left, at a motel at \$242 a night and 1.5kms away from where the Nationals are being held.
